He forced the flap of mucosa upward and drew the flap composed of musculosa and serosa outward, thus increasing vastly the denuded surface for coaptation, Hart and Barbour report that Dr. A. R. Simpson applied this flap method to perineorrhaphy. Not far from 1872, Mr. Lawson Tait applied the flap operation of Langenbeck, Colles and Duncan to the subject of perineorrhaphy. He added to all previous labors the use of sharp-pointed elbow scissors, and the introduction of the sutures without penetrating the skin or mucosa of vagina or rectum. Silkworm gut sutures are employed and may remain in situ for ten days to six weeks. According to Sanger, Stein, a Dane, and Voss, a Norwegian, used similar methods.
